WHEN: Sunday, March 2nd

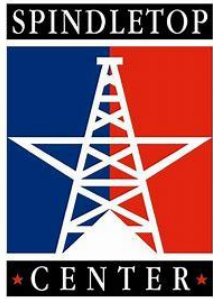
WHERE: Julie Rogers Theater, Beaumont, TX | 2:00pm

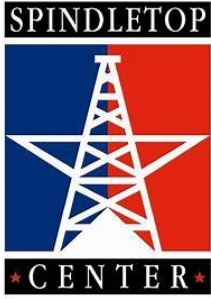
