## **Spindletop Center to Hold Ribbon Cutting and Open House Event for New Silsbee Community Behavioral Health Center on June 9**

BEAUMONT, Texas – Spindletop Center will host a ribbon cutting and open house event for its new Silsbee community behavioral health center located at 222 E. Durdin Dr, Silsbee, TX 77656 at 2:00PM on June 9.

Construction on the new building began in April of 2022. Spindletop Center served 1457 individuals in Hardin County during our most recent fiscal year and the new clinic aims to improve the access to a full array of behavioral health services for individuals in Jasper and Hardin counties. The new Spindletop Center facility in Silsbee will offer outpatient mental health services for children and adults, Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) services, Substance Use Disorder (SUD) services, as well as services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD).

“We are so excited to open this new facility in Silsbee to offer improved access to critical behavioral health services to residents of Hardin and Jasper counties,” said Spindletop Center CEO, Holly Borel. “Through this location, Spindletop Center will be able to expand our services and care to the area. This includes a full-service psychiatric clinic, care coordination, mental health counseling, substance use counseling and support, special therapy to babies, day habilitation and more.”

The new building is over 14,500 square feet and will be open for viewing and tours. Spindletop Center CEO, Holly Borel, will be in attendance to welcome visitors

“We want to increase services to our rural communities, bringing treatment and hope to those who may otherwise not receive care,” said Borel.
